ABSTRACT SUBMISSION – RULES & GUIDELINES

Submission Rules:

1. Language

All abstracts must be submitted and presented in clear, high-quality English, suitable for publication.

2. Author Responsibility

The submitting author must ensure that all co-authors are aware of the abstract's content prior to submission. This must be declared in the "Declarations" section.

3. Publication Consent

Submission of an abstract implies acceptance for its publication on the Congress Website and in the journal "Advancements in Health Research": https://www.ahr-journal.org/site.

4. Formatting Requirements

Abstracts must be prepared in accordance with the "Guidelines for Authors" provided by "Advancements in Health Research":

https://www.ahrjournal.org/site/guide.

5. Registration Requirement

Only abstracts submitted by registered authors (Abstract Submitter Fee) will be considered for publication.

6. Submission Limit

Each registered author may submit up to 3 abstracts.

7. Review Process

All abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee, which will decide on acceptance or rejection.

8. Original Content

All submitted abstracts must present novel data. Abstracts containing phrases such as "data will be discussed in the presentation" will not be accepted.

9. No Prior Presentation

Abstracts that have been previously presented at other congresses are not eligible for submission to #RPD-6

Submission Guidelines:

Before you begin, please carefully read the following information:

1. First Author/Corresponding Author Information

Please provide in the "AUTHOR SECTION" of the official website the following details for the first/corresponding author:

- → initial(s) of first name and last name(s) of the first author
- → e-mail address of the first author or corresponding author
- → Phone number of the first author or corresponding author
- → Affiliation of the first author: department, institution/hospital, city, state (if applicable), and country.

2. Co-authors Information

Please provide in the "CO-AUTHORS" field of the official website the following details:

- → initial(s) of first name and last name(s)
- → Affiliation: department, institution/hospital, city, state (if applicable), and country.

3. Number of Authors

Each abstract may list up to 8 authors, with one primary affiliation per author. Additional authors beyond the eighth will be deleted during processing.

4. Abstract Title

The title is limited to a maximum of 25 words.

5. Abstract Body

The abstract text must not exceed 250 words.

6. Images, Tables, and Graphs

You may include a maximum of 3 images per abstract.

→ Acceptable format for images, tables and graphs: JPG only

7. Editing Abstracts

Abstracts may be edited after submission until the official submission deadline.

→ After the deadline, no further modifications will be possible.

8. Submission Process

Abstracts must be uploaded via the official congress website.

You may use the "Save and Resume Later" option to save your draft and change it until the deadline. Once an abstract is saved, it cannot be edited. To make changes, you must delete the saved abstract and submit a new one.

To finalize submission, you must click "**Submit Abstract**" before the deadline. Once submitted, no further changes can be made.

9. Publication & E-Posters

All accepted abstracts will be published in the journal "Advancements in Health Research".

After submitting your abstract(s), an official confirmation of acceptance will be sent to you via email by the Organizing Secretariat together with instructions for preparing your E-Poster, which must be uploaded via the website.

E-posters will be displayed in the main hall and galleries of the Congress Center.

10. Award-Winning Abstracts

If your abstract is selected as a winner, the Organizing Secretariat will contact you by e-mail with instructions to prepare a short oral presentation, which will be delivered in the Plenary Room during dedicated sessions.

11. Abstract Layout

Abstracts must be submitted with the following sections:

- i. Background and aims
- ii. Methods
- iii. Results
- iv. Conclusions

12. Abstract Submitter's Declaration

In submitting the abstract, the abstract submitter is declaring to confirm the following:

- i. I, the Abstract Submitter, confirm that I previewed this abstract and that all information are correct.
- ii. Accept that the content of this abstract cannot be modified or corrected after final submission, and I am aware that it will be published exactly as submitted.
- iii. Submission of the abstract constitutes my consent to publication (e.g., congress website, programs, journal, other promotions, etc.).
- iv. Warrant and represent that I am the sole owner or have the rights of all the information and content ("Content") provided to the RPD6 and Fondazione Paolo Procacci ("The Organizers").
