An adequate slot will be given to the diagnostic procedures, especially as a support to invasive management of pain. For this the Paolo Foundation counts completely on SonoPain and GPS, a group of Colleagues who perceive this as their important mission in educating the new generations of Pain Physicians. One of the rooms of the congress center is dedicated to this important aspect of pain management. Also, we will still have with us the FEDELAT Colleagues, with their educational proposals. The Latino-American Pain Physicians are particularly eager to gain new knowledge in Pain Medicine, and they have chosen #RPD23 as the most promising, best link with European culture on this topic.


